Subject: Updated: Thursday Promoter Practice

Except where otherwise announced by AMA Pro Racing, effective June 8, 2009, (following the Barber, Infineon and Road America events) AMA Pro Racing shall prohibit any competitors who have entered any American Superbike or Daytona SportBike competition from engaging in any on track activities at any race track holding an AMA Pro Racing sanctioned event, within three days of that event.

During the 2009 season, several of the venues that are producing AMA Pro Racing National Road Race events, will be conducting Track Day events prior to the AMA Pro Racing National events. These Track Days are intended to provide an opportunity for amateur sportsman riders to experience the excitement of the AMA Pro Racing National weekend and to ride on the tracks that the Pro's compete on during the National weekend.

However, these Track Day Riding experience programs are not intended to provide additional testing opportunities for professional teams. Some AMA Pro Racing media and promotional activity will be conducted during the Thursday Track Day and these activities will be used solely to expose media representatives to the sport and to generate publicity for the purpose of promoting the weekend's AMA Pro Racing Road Race National events.

Media activities will continue to be coordinated with the local event promoters and their media contacts on a case-by-case basis and these limited on track activities will not be considered to violate the restrictions listed above.
