Subject: Pomona Rules Information

All West Coast Flat Track Series (WCFTS) riders that will compete in the AMA Pro Singles and Expert Twins classes at the AMA Pro Flat Track/WCFTS event at the Fairplex in Pomona, California on October 24, 2009, **MUST** be in compliance with the 2009 AMA Pro Flat Track Rule Book, which can be found at AMA Pro Racing's website, www.amaproracing.com, in the competitor information section. It is also understood that WCFTS riders participating in the AMA Pro Singles and Expert Twins classes are not required to retain an AMA Pro Membership or an AMA Pro competition license. Riders competing in just the WCFTS classes will compete under existing WCFTS rules. AMA Pro membership is NOT required to purchase pit passes for this event.

This will include, but not be limited to, the following items:

- Age Requirements:** An AMA Pro Racing "Pro License" is issued to eligible riders who have reached the age of 16 years.
- Restrictors:** Proper size and location. They need to be shown to technical officials on demand at any time during the event. For restrictors please contact:

Dunlop/Goodyear DT-11 27.0x7.0-19 D3616/CD-5
 - ii. Rear Tire-All Flat Tracks
Dunlop/Goodyear DT-11 27.5x7.5-19 D1637/CD-8
