MOTOCROSS LICENSE CRITERIA

All license applicants must be at least 16 years of age at the time of application. A Motocross license allows a rider to compete in either the 250 or 450 Motocross Classes; however, riders may only participate in one class per event. A Motocross license can be issued to any rider that has met one of the following requirements:

Please place a check next to the applicable experience requirement you have met.

- Earned at least 75 advancement points (at the time of application) in the AMA PRO-AM Motocross Series.
- Finished in the top 15 overall positions, in the AMA Amateur National Motocross Championship in 2008 or 2009 in an A or Pro Sport class.
- Earned 50 Arenacross class points in 2007-2008 AMA Arenacross Series or 35 points in the 2009 AMA Arenacross Series.
- Earned 75 Arenacross Lites class points in 2007-2008 AMA Arenacross Series or 60 points in the 2009 AMA Arenacross Lites Series.
- AMA Pro Racing may issue a license to any rider who does not meet the above criteria if it determines, in its sole discretion, that the rider has adequate competition experience.
