



## ***Technical Bulletin #2020-02***

**Subject:** 2020 American Flat Track Rulebook Amendments

The following amendments have been made to the 2020 American Flat Track Rulebook, effective immediately:

### **1.2 Credential Policies**

- h. The competitor paddock at American Flat Track events will be limited to only essential personnel. Essential personnel are the absolute minimum number of people required to directly and safely enable racing, conduct the event and produce a television / streaming broadcast. Directly means that the person must be physically present to execute their role in enabling the motorcycle to function and the race / race broadcasts to occur.
- i. Organizations participating in the event (race teams, race support vendors, industry partners, broadcasters) must submit a list of the minimum essential personnel required to safely conduct the Event via an Event Roster. Roster limits will be announced on an event-by-event basis and will be strictly enforced by AMA Pro Racing. Event Rosters must be approved by AMA Pro Racing and all personnel will undergo medical screening before, during and after each Event.
- j. In its sole discretion, AMA Pro Racing may determine someone to be non-essential and dismiss them from the event. Teams and participants may also be in violation of Section 1.7 of the American Flat Track Rulebook if they fail to comply with the essential personnel rules.

### **1.7 Code of Conduct**

- n. All Members must comply with the American Flat Track Event Operations Protocol and/or instructions from AMA Pro Racing with regards to medical screenings, social distancing, compartmentalization, and use of required personal protective equipment, etc.
- o. Failure to comply with the American Flat Track Event Operations Protocol and any other directives issued by AMA Pro Racing may result in penalties including monetary fines, disqualification or suspension.
