Subject: Penalty Information for the 2021 Port Royal Half-Mile (REVISED)

1. At the conclusion of the AFT Singles Qualifying session #2 at the Port Royal round of the 2021 Progressive American Flat Track series, all competitors reported to technical impound where the rear wheels were removed for a weight and internal tire inspection. As a result of that inspection, the following was determined:

#21 was found in violation of the following rules:

- A2.3, k. Failure to submit machine component for inspection
- A3.1, a. Equipment Violation; device other than standard single inner tube inside wheel

Effective immediately, #21 has been served with the following penalties in accordance with section A3.3

- Disqualification from Qualifying Session #2
- Loss of 10 Championship points
- \$2,500 fine
- 12-month technical probation

2. At the conclusion of the AFT Singles Main Event at the Port Royal round of the 2021 Progressive American Flat Track series, there was an altercation between a rider and a crew member in the technical impound area. As a result of an extensive investigation and based on eyewitness testimony from AMA Pro officials and other witnesses, the following was determined:

The Crew member had attacked and struck the rider and was found in violation of the following rule:

- A2.3 j. A physical or verbal attack on an AMA Pro Racing official and / or engaging in a fight. This includes any person who attacks or is involved in a fight anywhere on the premises prior to, during, or after an AMA Pro Racing event. There will be no maximum fine or suspension period for this offense.

Effective immediately, the crew member has been served with the following penalty in accordance with section A3.3

- ~~12-month suspension from AMA Pro Racing sanctioned events~~

3. At the conclusion of the AFT SuperTwins Main Event at the Port Royal round of the 2021 Progressive American Flat Track series, the flywheel was weighed and inspected on all race-only machines. As a result of that inspection, the following was determined:

#72 was found in violation of the following rules:

- A3.1, a. Equipment Violation; Flywheel was found out of compliance

Effective immediately, #72 has been served with the following penalty in accordance with section A3.3

- Disqualification from the Main Event



REVISED (7/29/2021): Joe RoosEvans has appealed his penalty in accordance with the rules set forth in Appendix A5 of the 2015 AMA Pro Flat Track rulebook.

REVISED (8/6/2021): AMA Pro Racing has modified the penalty issued against RoosEvans pursuant rule A5.6:

“Following the submission of an appeal, AMA Pro Racing shall take one of three initial actions:

- a. Rule in favor of the appealing party, take appropriate remedial action and refund the filing fee.
- b. Convene an appeal board.
- c. Determine the appeal to be without merit...”

AMA Pro Racing has modified the penalty as follows:

- Suspension from AMA Pro Racing sanctioned events through the end of the 2021 American Flat Track Championship season. This suspension will end at the conclusion of the final event of the 2021 season.
- Probation for the 2022 American Flat Track Championship season.
