Subject: Rule Clarification and Springfield Short Track Main 1 Results

Following review of Main 1 at the Springfield Short Track, it has been determined that a further clarification is needed in Section 2.23 for races that are red flagged and NOT restarted. The following change has been made to further clarify the intent of the rules.

2.23 Race Finishes and Ordering of Results

a. Race Finishes

...

- iv. Should a race not be restarted after a red flag, riders finishing positions will be declared as their race positions on the Lap of Record, not their physical track positions at the time of the red flag. ***Rider(s) deemed to be the cause of the red flag will be moved to the back of their respective lap groups in the final results. If a clear determination as to the cause of the red flag cannot be made, all riders involved in the red flag incident will be moved to the back of their respective lap group in the final results.***

Based on this clarification, scoring reverted to the running order on Lap 27, the Lap of Record being defined as the last lap completed by all active riders on the Lead Lap. #21 Trevor Brunner was the sole rider determined to be the cause of the red flag ending the race and was subsequently moved to the back of his lap group.
