Requirements:

- Bodywork with standard production colors must be used.
- Honda logo must be legible and prominently featured on the machine.
- Honda logo must be located on both sides of either the seat, radiator shrouds or front and rear fender.

How to Register:

- The Honda CRF450R Sales Registration must be on file with AHM prior to race date.
- All Honda contingency awards will be paid via XTRM AnyPay™ digital wallet.
- Payments will only be issued to the person named on the Sales Registration on file with American Honda.
- Competitors have 45 days from the date of the race to inquire about missing payments.
- Competitors MUST enroll and verify registered VIN for qualifying vehicles.

Husqvarna 2018 or newer FC 450

- Husqvarna Motorcycles North America Inc. reserves the right to modify or amend this program without notice or obligation. Please review all rules before registering.
- Contingency must be claimed and collected within 60 days of the race. No exceptions will be made. A rider has 60 days from the date of the race to claim awards regardless of whether it is for cash or dealer credit. For dealer credit, rider shall claim their award within 60 days, but they have up to a year to redeem it.
- Pro Payments that are designated with a cash award are paid via a debit card. Debit Cards will be mailed to qualifying riders after all required forms are submitted. All cash payouts via debit cards will be paid within 30 days of results verification. Contingency can only be collected within 60 days of the race.
- Only motorcycles containing a genuine Husqvarna Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) are eligible. VIN WILL BE VERIFIED.
- The Husqvarna Motorcycles logo and plastic components must be displayed on the Husqvarna motorcycle for contingency eligibility. For example: a rider will not be able to collect contingency awards if the rider changes the plastics from the stock OEM color (white) to another color and/or removing the Husqvarna emblem, logos and branding elements. We reserve the right to repeal awards based on the appearance of the motorcycle as seen in photos or videos from races. - Rider must own the motorcycle. Contingency not eligible when riding a dealer demo or loaned bike.
- Must ride a Husqvarna motorcycle for the entire series to be eligible for series-end results.

- Kawasaki Lime Green <u>must</u> be the dominant color
- Kawasaki logos <u>must</u> (black or white only) be on both sides of the motorcycle.
- Kawasaki <u>must</u> be on the chest portion of leathers. Patches can be purchased or requested from Team Green at <u>https://www.kawasaki.com/</u>.
- Prior to enrolling, participants must contact Team Green at 949-716-0351 for additional information about how to enroll.

KTM

2018 or newer 450 SX-F

- Must ride a 2017 or newer KTM motorcycle to be eligible
- Only motorcycles containing a genuine KTM Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) are eligible
- The KTM logo and plastic components must be displayed on the KTM motorcycle for contingency eligibility
- A minimum of 6 riders per class must be present for KTM Contingency to be awarded

- Competitors must <u>enroll</u> and verify registered VIN for qualifying vehicles.
- U.S. certified models sold by authorized Suzuki dealers are eligible.
- The Suzuki logo (all models) and standard production colors must be predominantly featured on the machine. There will be no updating of Suzuki equipment. A given model year must remain stock per that model year's Suzuki service manual.
 - For example, you may not install a 2015 RM-Z250 model year engine into a 2016 RM-ZZ250 model year frame. In the case of flat track, for modified SV engines maybe used without frame.
- A Suzuki logo must be visible on both sides of the main fairing or on both sides of the tail section or swingarm.
- The Suzuki logo must remain on the gas tank.
- Factory-supported teams and/or riders are ineligible for Suzuki contingency.
- Competitors have 45 days from the date of the race to inquire about missing payments.
- Claims received more than 45 days after the race will not be processed.
- In cases of dual sanctioned events, the rider will be paid for one event only.
- Riders will be paid for (2) classes per registered motorcycle. If more than
 (2) classes are raced, the rider will be paid for the (2) highest earning amounts.

Yamaha YZ450F Motorcycles

- The "Yamaha" and logo <u>must</u> be displayed on the left and right side of all motorcycles and the "*bLU cRU*" logo must be displayed on the front number plate of all machines to be eligible.
- The "Yamaha" logo <u>must</u> be displayed on the chest of the rider's leathers and "bLU cRU" logo <u>must</u> be displayed on the rider's right shoulder to be eligible.
- Contingency will be paid to the Warranty Registered owner. If warranty registered owner will not be competing, but sponsoring a rider, contingency will be paid to the rider.
- Contingency will be paid on rider's best finish in one class only, per registered machine.
- There will be no multiple class payouts at the same event for the same machine.
- Riders must submit a 2020 Contingency Registration form by November 30, 2020 to be eligible.
- In addition to registration, riders must submit a signed <u>W-9 form.</u>
- Following registration bLU cRU winners will be paid by check after Yamaha receives confirmation of results.
- Competitors MUST enroll and verify registered VIN for qualifying vehicles.


