Subject: 2015 Harley-Davidson Payout Structure for GNC1

As part of the official partnership with AMA Pro Racing, Harley-Davidson will pay out a total of \$126,000 in per-race and year-end contingency throughout the 2015 AMA Pro Flat Track season.

Harley-Davidson has posted \$101,000 towards a per-race payout structure eligible to all riders in the Harley-Davidson GNC1 presented by Vance & Hines class, regardless of the brand of motorcycle entered.

Harley-Davidson's per-race payout structure for GNC1 Twins events:

1st - \$2,500 2nd - \$1,500 3rd - \$1,250 4th - \$750

5th - \$500

Fastest lap of the GNC1 Main - \$250

Harley-Davidson's per-race payout structure for GNC1 Singles events\*:

1st - \$2,000 2nd - \$1,250 3rd - \$750

4th - \$500

5th - \$250

Fastest lap of the GNC1 Main - \$250

\* The payout structure for the GNC1 Singles events will be retroactively paid out for the two DAYTONA Flat Track races held on March 12 and 13, 2015.

All GNC1 riders must display the Harley-Davidson sticker on their front number plate, regardless of the brand of motorcycle the rider competes on.

A \$25,000 year-end contingency award will go to the GNC1 rider earning the most points while competing on Harley-Davidson equipment during the 2015 season. In order to be eligible for the year-end contingency award, GNC1 riders must display the Harley-Davidson logo on the chest of their leathers.
