**Subject:** On-board camera regulations and inspection reminder

All on-board cameras must comply with the following rules, as stated in the 2015 AMA Pro Flat Track Rulebook:

### 3.24 Telemetry, Traction Control and Video

- c. On-board cameras are permitted. **An On-Track Camera Authorization form must be filled out at tech prior to an event unless the camera is fitted by and for our television partners.** In addition, the following stipulations apply:
  - i. **Cameras must be secured to the motorcycle with safety wire and/or a tether in addition to the standard camera mount. Any on-board camera that becomes detached from a motorcycle may not be re-installed for the remainder of the event. Additional penalties may be imposed.**
  - ii. On-board cameras must be mounted within the body/ frame envelope of the motorcycle and cannot be positioned where it may be struck by a passing bike or rider. If unsure of suitable mounting positions, check with AMA Pro tech for clarity and approval.
  - iii. On-board cameras may not be attached to the rider in any way. This includes, but is not limited to, chest or back protectors and/or helmets.
  - iv. **On-board cameras must have the riders name and competition number clearly indicated on the camera and external case.**

**NOTE: Camera mounts must be installed before the motorcycle passes through technical inspection. Mounts cannot be installed after the motorcycle has been inspected and approved.**
