The 2017 American Flat Track season was a year of transformation which saw major changes and required the close consultation with a wide group of experts from the community. The 2018 season will see fewer major changes to the competition structure and event format, and will have a more streamlined, five-person Advisory Group.

Voting Results

The 2018 American Flat Track Advisory Group is comprised of five members from two categories: Riders and Team Members. Following nominations and voting, the two members with the highest number of votes in each category were named as the first four members of the Advisory Group. The final seat was filled by the nominee with the highest number of votes, regardless of category, and is designated with the * in the table below.
