NOTE:

When Riders use a Provisional Start, Championship Purse Money will be distributed as follows:

The additional paying position (typically 17th place, unless the number of Riders in the Final has been reduced) will receive the same payout as the final paying position before the Provisional Starter was added. For example, 17th place will be awarded the same amount as 16th place.

Example: If the Provisional Starter finishes 10th, with a purse of \$1,050, and the original final paying position (16th) receives \$750, then the added 17th position will be awarded \$750 from the Provisional Starter's payout. The Provisional Starter will receive the remaining \$300.
